As a religious worker, your responsibilities will include:

- Assisting the head priest and other priests in performing sacraments for religious events, as well as tending to the sick, needy, and elderly members of the Sikh community.
- Playing musical instruments during Kirtan performances by the head priest for the local congregation.
- Organizing, coordinating, and promoting community-based activities and initiatives.
- Reporting to the Gurudwara administrator, chairperson, or another designated representative of the employer.
- Ensuring cleanliness and hygiene at the premises.
- Adhering to Gurudwara rules, processes, procedures, and policies.
- Being accountable for a range of activities as required by the Gurudwara Sahib in a non-pastoral role.
